
Why open a coffee shop?

The Coffee Community Collective was created as a means to remove barriers for people living across northern Hamilton County. In a culture where it is difficult to ask for help, a coffee shop offers a safe and comfortable environment for our neighbors to enter to share their stories and needs. Another goal was also to offer meeting space in a community where there are limited places to gather.

Stability Story

Our Case Manager had a neighbor who was out of work for 8 weeks while recovering from knee surgery. After using her paid time off and her savings to sustain herself while she was recovering, she was facing eviction when she was ready to return to work. NNH was able to cover her rent for a month, giving her time to get back on her feet. When one of our case managers followed up with her 3 months later, they found out that our neighbor had been able to get back to work, maintain her housing, and get caught up on all of her bills.
