COMMUNITY Schools

Northside Neighborhood House's COMMUNITY Schools serve as a resource hub that empowers and equips the community by promoting education, well being, and independence to students and families.

Last year, we established five new COMMUNITY Schools, expanding our presence to a total of ten schools in Northern Hamilton County!



We also had...

1,174

students referred to our CS Coordinators for student or family support in school.



94%

of students moved up to the next grade on time,



70%

had four or less absences,

86%

of all classes were passed, and

100%

of high school seniors that participated in programs graduated on time!





Over the last year, NNH also focused on providing more access to stability services to our COMMUNITY School students and families. We had...

121 referrals from Coordinators in our COMMUNITY Schools,

73 referrals from Hamilton County School social workers, totaling

194 referrals to our stability program.

Out of these referrals, we assisted

59% of these families for the first time.

We were able to provide

1,436 items to students through

998 care closet visits, and gave out

\$2,640 in Thrift Store vouchers to students and families, and

\$19,060



in financial services, including rent, utilities, medication, gas cards, and thrift vouchers.
