\$1,661 AVERAGE MONTHLY INCOME

AVERAGE COST OF RENT **\$1,056**

59% OF MONTHLY INCOME

for the average renter is spent on rental costs

AVERAGE MONTHLY DEFICIT AFTER BILLS PAID **-\$325**

83% make less than \$30,000 per year

50% ARE EMPLOYED (full-time or part-time)
