Under nursing supervision, Psychiatric Technicians at Moccasin Bend Mental Health Institute (MBMHI) provide direct care to patients in Short Term Care Programs; Extended Care Programs; and, Forensic Care Programs for those who have been diagnosed with a mental illness and have forensic charges.

Responsibilities of this position include providing daily living care for patients such as bathing and personal hygiene; assisting with dressing (clothes); and, feeding.
