Responsibilities of this position include providing daily living care for patients such as bathing and personal hygiene; assisting with dressing (clothes); and, feeding. Psychiatric Technicians must have the ability to move, lift, and/or transfer patients using sliding boards, wheel chairs, or other required equipment; as well as provide supervised medical assistance, such as, but not limited to, obtaining vital signs and weights of patients. Psychiatric Technicians escort patients to appointments and other appropriate areas; and, they provide individualized teaching and leading activities for patients. This individual is required to make rounds according to policy and procedure to account for each assigned patient; provide verbal de-escalation of agitated patients; and, perform CPR and other emergency responses and techniques when necessary. Psychiatric Technicians must be able to lift 30 – 50 lbs. and perform repetitive tasks consisting of bending, stooping, standing and walking.
